BREACH OF CONDITION NOTICE

Issued by Gateshead Council

1. This is a formal notice which is issued by the Council under Section 187A of the above Act, because they consider that a condition or conditions imposed on a grant of planning permission relating to the land described below has not been complied with. They consider that you should be required to comply or secure compliance with the conditions specified in this notice.

2. The land affected by this notice.

The land at Whickham Industrial Estate, Swalwell shown edged in red on the attached plan.

3. The relevant planning permission.

The relevant planning permission to which this notice relates is the permission granted by the Planning Inspectorate on 19 November 2001 for the change of use from a builder's yard to use for the sale, fitting and storage of tyres.

4. The breach of condition.

The following conditions have not been complied with.

Condition 2

Within 8 months of the date this letter no tyres or other materials shall be stored in the open (that is outside the existing building or any other building or container subsequently approved in writing by the Council) on any part of the site.

Reference to 'this letter' in the above condition refers to the Decision Notice issued by the Planning Inspectorate 19 November 2001.

A copy of the letter is attached in Annex 1 to this notice.

5. What you are required to do.

You are required to comply or secure compliance with the stated condition by taking the following steps.

In order to comply with Condition 2 you should remove all tyres and other materials that are stored in the open on any part of the land outlined in red on the plan attached to this notice.

Supply copies of invoices and other written evidence showing lawful disposal of the tyres from the land to the Environment Agency.

Time for compliance 6 weeks beginning with the day this notice is served on you.

6. When this notice takes effect.

This notice takes effect immediately it is served on you or you receive it by postal delivery.

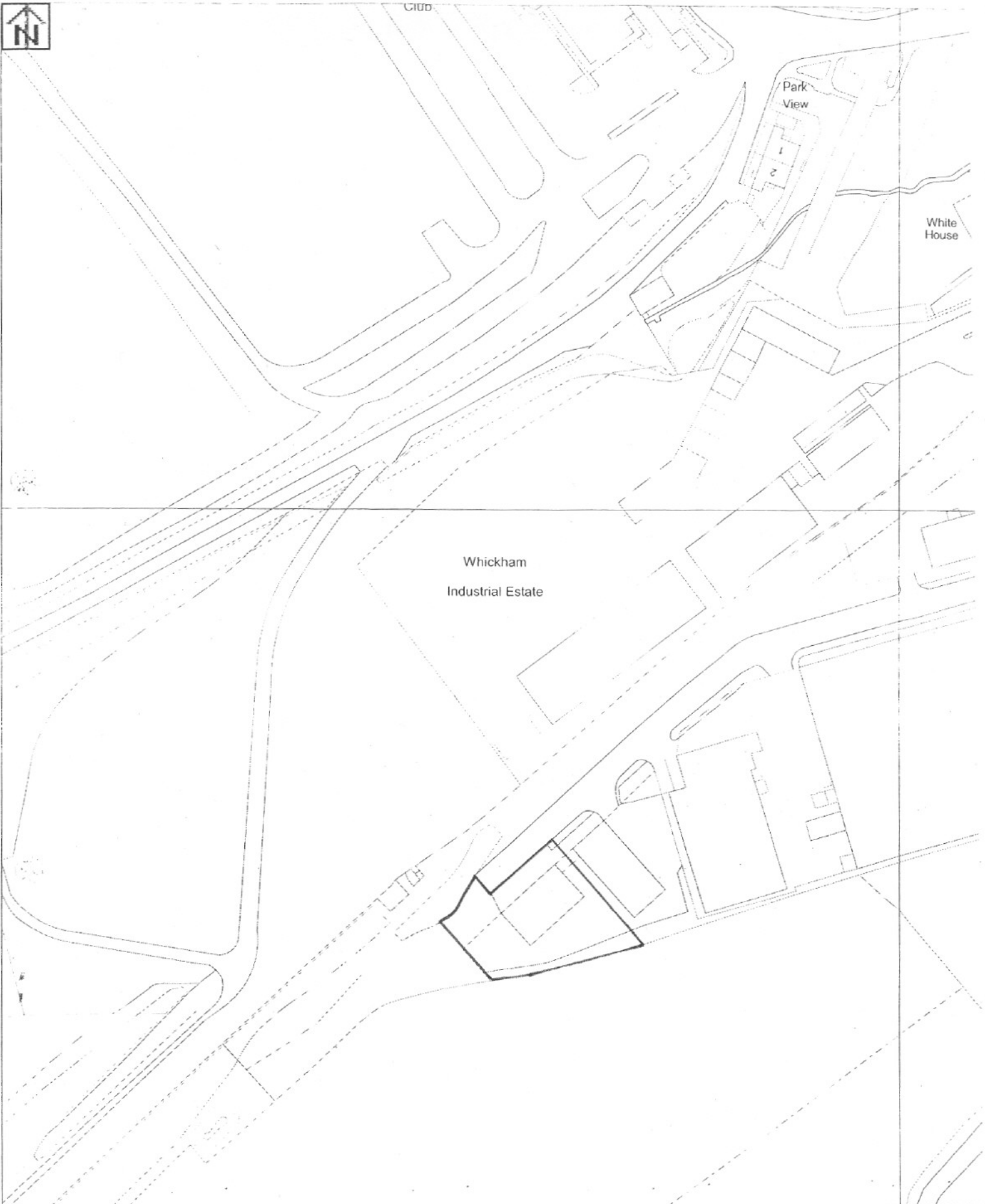
Warning:

If you need independent advice about this notice, you are advised to contact urgently a solicitor, planning consultant or other professional adviser specialising in planning matters. If you wish to contest the validity of the notice, you may only do so by an application to the High Court for judicial review. A solicitor will advise you on what this procedure involves.
