Introduction

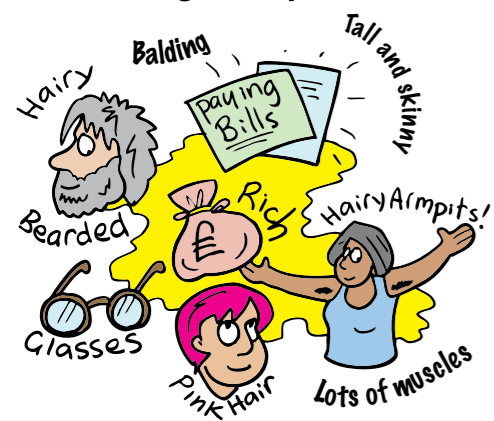

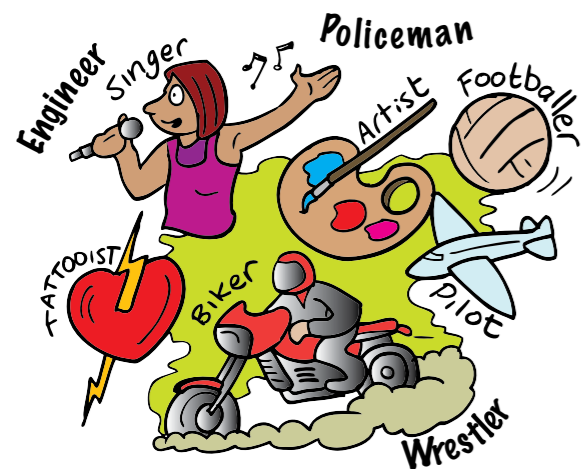

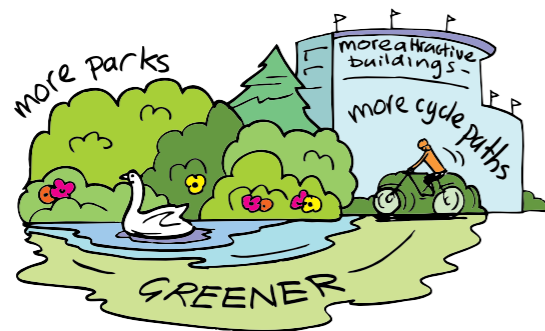

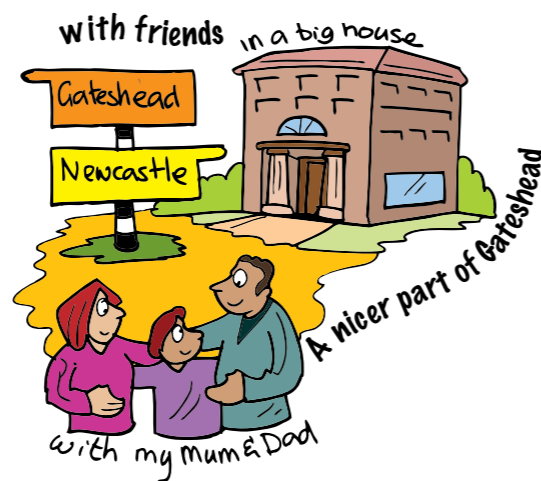

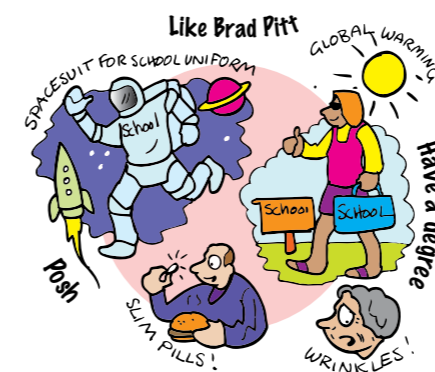

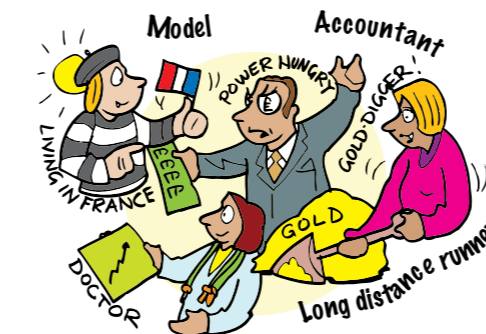

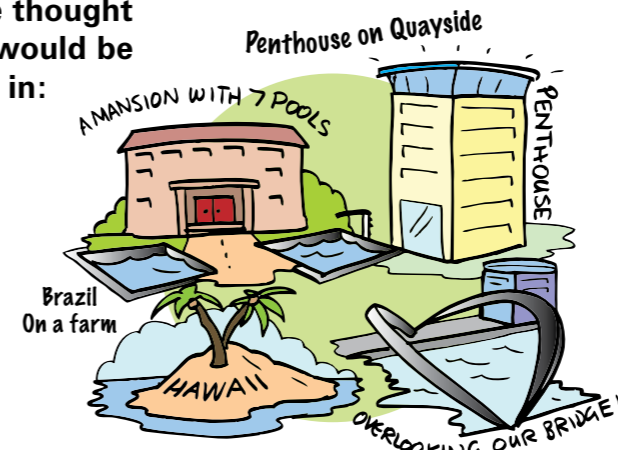
