

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(BUS LANES GATESHEAD) (AMENDMENT NO. 3)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 23rd October 2019 the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 19 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order which comes into force on the 30th October 2019 will be to amend the Borough Council of Gateshead (Bus Lanes) Traffic Regulation Order 2014 by introducing a new bus gate along the length of road listed in Schedule 1 below with exemptions for buses, pedal cycles, Hackney Carriages and Authorised Vehicles.

The Order together with plans and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead, NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8:45am and 5:30pm and Friday between 8:45am and 5:00pm or online at: www.gateshead.gov.uk/trafficschemes (Ref: TS/1330)

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
