

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORT TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 251 of the above Act to authorise the extinguishment of public rights of way of an irregular shaped area of Russel Court as lies off Northumberland Street and Watson Street in the Metropolitan Borough of Gateshead, provided that the land subject to the public right of way, has been acquired or appropriated for planning purposes by Gateshead Council.
