**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 – SECTION 251**

**EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY (NORTH EAST) (NO. ) ORDER 202**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State in exercise of powers under Section 251 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 has made the above Order.

This Order is made by the Secretary of State because:-

- (a) the land which is subject to the public right of way described in the Schedule to this Order (“the Schedule”) has been acquired or appropriated for planning purposes and is for the time being held by Gateshead Council (“the Council”) for the purpose for which it was acquired or appropriated;
- (b) the Council has requested the Secretary of State to extinguish the said public right of way by Order; and
- (c) the Secretary of State is satisfied that alternative rights of way are not required.

BY THIS ORDER the public rights of way shown on the plan numbered NATTRAN/NE/S251/4203 and marked “Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way at Gateshead in the Metropolitan Borough of Gateshead (“the Plan”), and described in the Schedule are extinguished on 202 .

**THE SCHEDULE**

The public rights of way to be extinguished are at Gateshead in the Metropolitan Borough of Gateshead, shown on the plan and is an irregular shaped area of Russell Court as lies off Northumberland Street and Watson Street. It commences 13.5 metres south west of the south western corner of the Teams Medical Practice extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of 51.3 metres and having a maximum width of 54.2 metres.
