WHICKHAM


NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead, as Highway Authority for Gateshead, INTENDS to apply to the Mid and South East Northumberland Magistrates' Court sitting at The Law Courts, Bedlington, NE22 7LX on the 9th November at 11:30am for an Order under Section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the stopping-up of an area of the highway being the footway located at Rectory Lane, Gateshead, which runs in a north/south direction for a length of 6.5m and has a width of 1.5m making an area of 9.8m², shown hatched red on the plan, on the ground that the highway is unnecessary. The effect of the Order will be to extinguish all public rights of way over the said land.
