

# Bridges Ward Factsheet

Bridges ward is located in Central Gateshead along with three other wards – Deckham, Lobley Hill and Bensham, and Saltwell. It is bordered to the north by the River Tyne and contains Gateshead Town Centre.

The area is served by the Metro and contains a number of industrial estates, all located on or near to the riverbank.

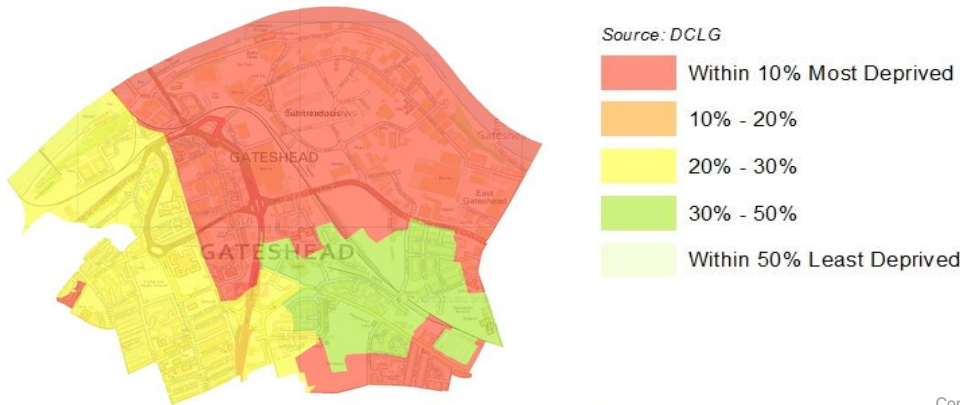
The area has a significant number of traditional Tyneside flats and similar terraced houses along with high density maisonettes and tower blocks in the west of the ward.

The revitalisation of the riverbank is well underway and includes BALTIC, The Sage Gateshead and the Hilton International Hotel.

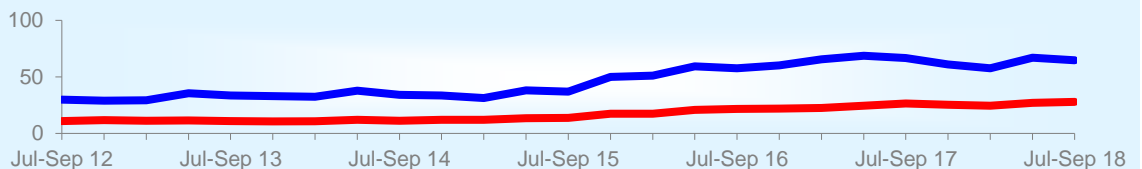

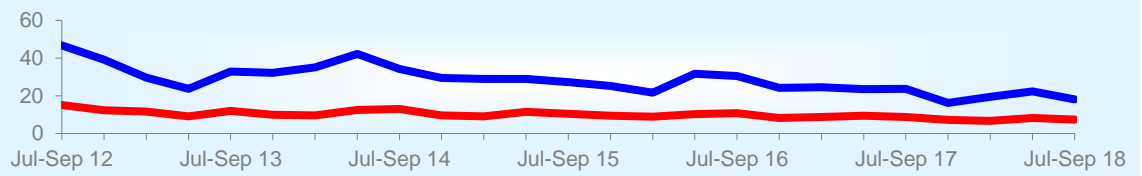

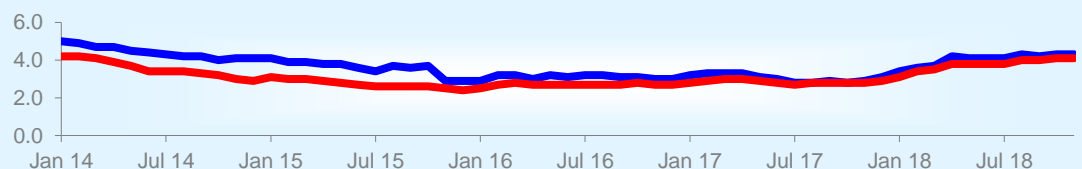

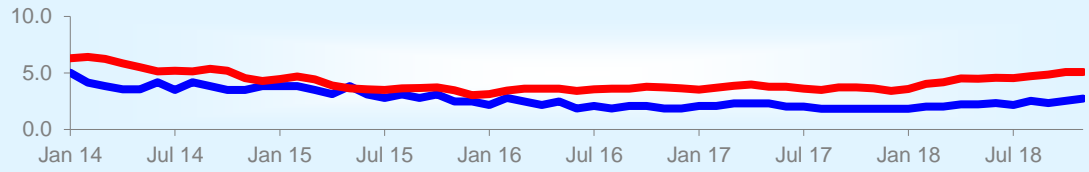

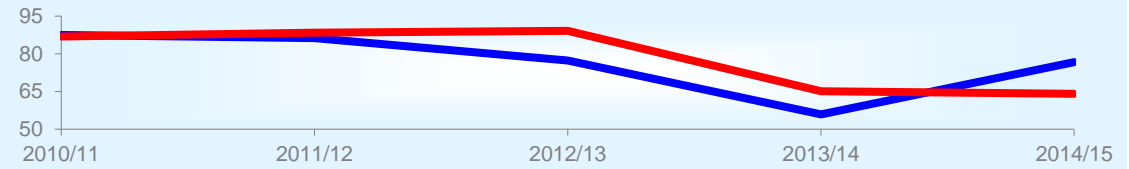

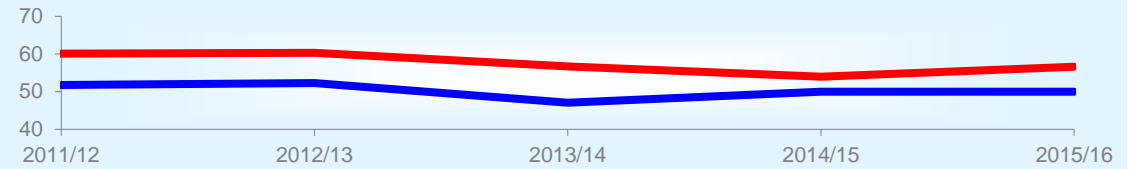

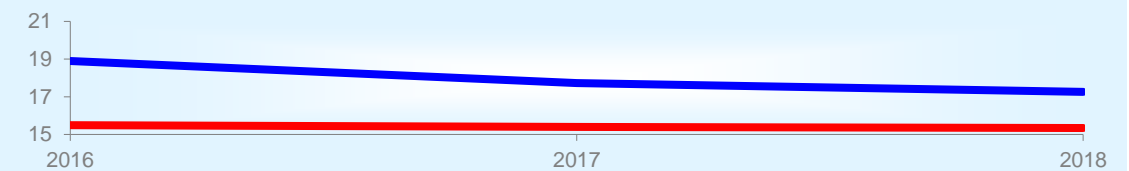

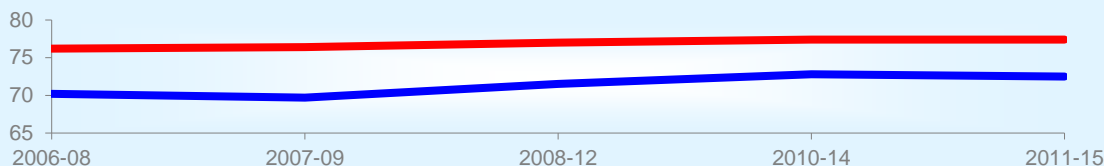

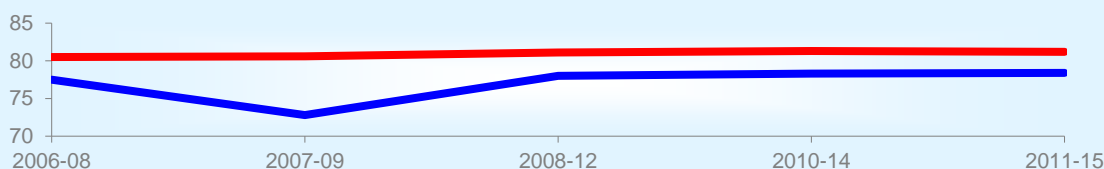
