

High Fell Ward Factsheet

High Fell ward is located in the South of Gateshead along with four other wards – Birtley, Chowdene, Lamesley, and Low Fell.

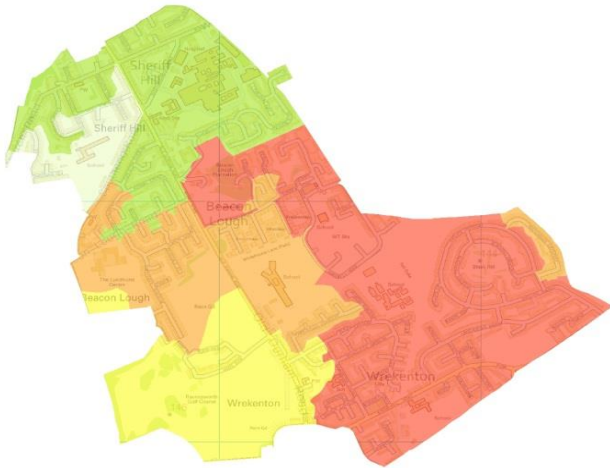
The ward contains the Queen Elizabeth Hospital and a significant part of Ravensworth Golf Course. The locality has a number of open spaces including some large playing fields.

There are several large Council estates in the ward. Beacon Lough contains a large proportion of non-traditional council housing, whilst the older, more established area of Wrekenton contains a mix of housing types. Beacon Lough East has three multi-storey blocks of flats.

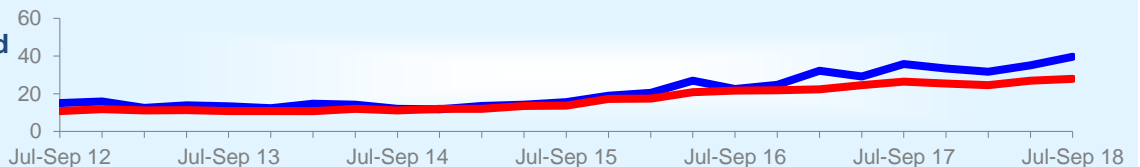

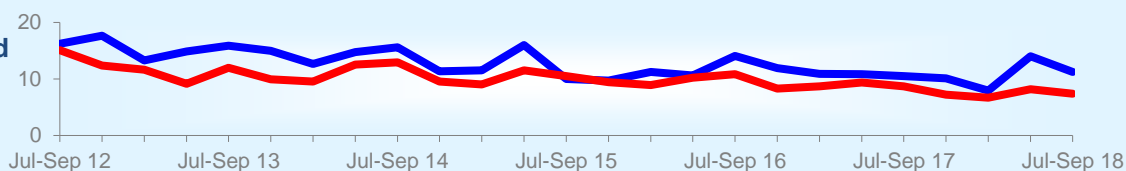

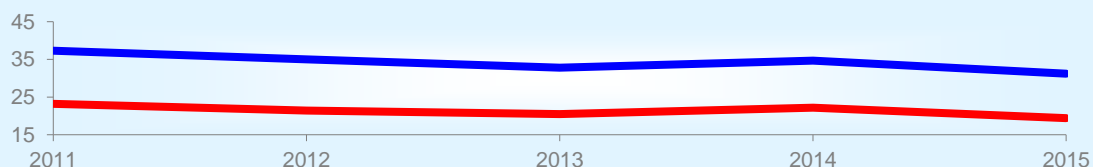

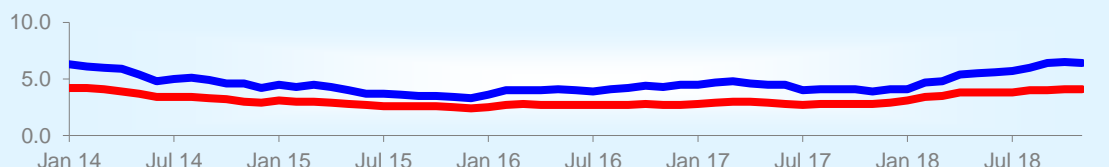

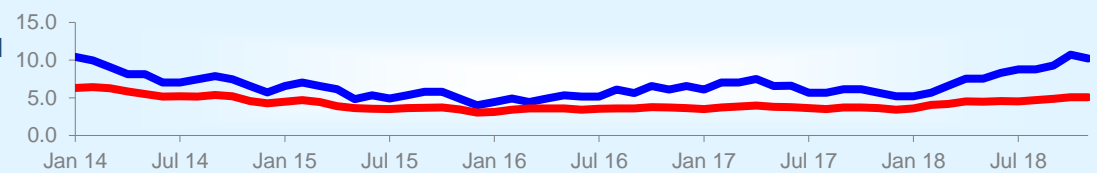

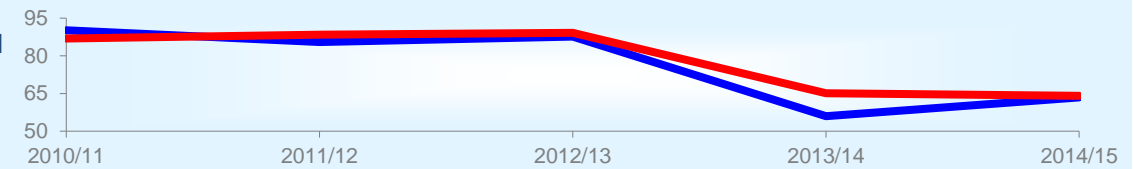

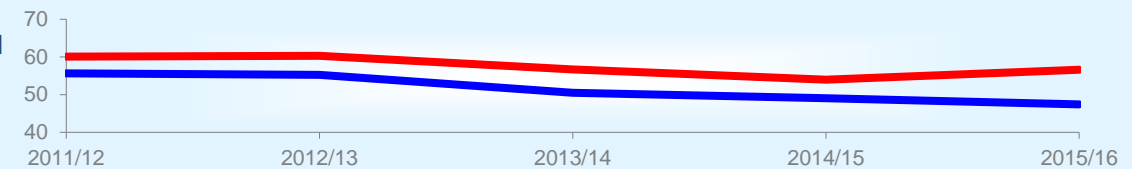

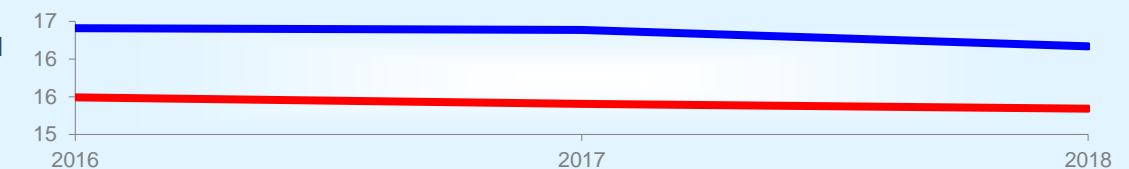

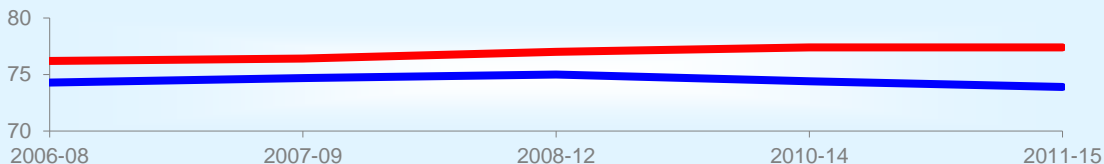

Female Life Expectancy, PHE/ONS (Current data: 2011-15)

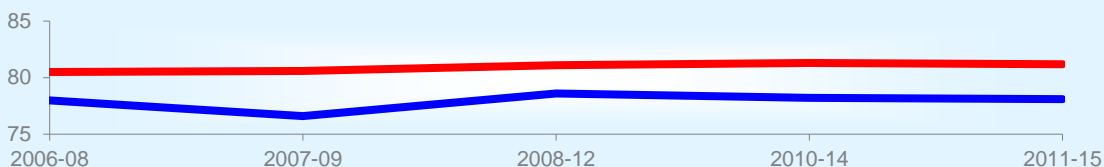

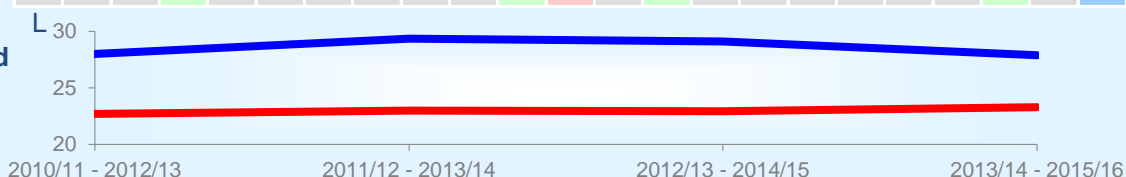
